



The GP is your community medical doctor. They often work with nurses, physiotherapists, pharmacists and psychologists. You need to register with a GP close to where you live.

Your GP can assess and treat you. They may refer you to a specialist in hospital, if needed.

If you need urgent care and immediate help, call the emergency number 999 for an ambulance.
